Concerns of Organisations Establishing and Implementing ISMS to ISO/IEC 27001

- Meet the requirements of ISO/IEC 27001 ?
- Effectiveness?
- Continual improvement ?



Certification is an attestation issued by a third-party body, through a formal conformity assessment process, that specified requirements (e.g. ISO/IEC 27001) are fulfilled.





Certification of ISMS (ISMS 認證)

- Initial certification (Stage 1 and Stage 2)
- Annual surveillance
- Re-certification (usually 3 years cycle)







What is accreditation (認可)?







Definition of Accreditation (認可)

- According to ISO/IEC 17000:2004 Conformity assessment – Vocabulary and general principles:
 - "Accreditation" Issuance of conformance statement by <u>a third party</u> (i.e. accreditation body) to a <u>conformity assessment body</u> (i.e. laboratory, inspection body or <u>certification</u> body, validation and verification body)
 - Conveying formal demonstration of its competence to carry our specific conformity assessment tasks (i.e. testing, inspection, certification, GHG validation and verification)









Accreditation helps managing the risk










What is Hong Kong Accreditation Service?

 HKAS is part of Innovation and Technology Commission of the Hong Kong Special Administration Region (HKSAR) Government.



Established in 1985 (formerly named as HOKLAS), HKAS is the official accreditation body (認可資格頒授機構) in Hong Kong

- Provide accreditation services under 3 schemes:









Accreditation Recognised Internationally






Mutual recognition arrangement (MRA) through international and regional co-operations

Information Security Management System Certification

Application for HKAS accreditation is open to any information security management system (ISMS) certification body which complies with HKAS 002, ISO/IEC 17021:2011, ISO/IEC 17021-1:2015, ISO/IEC 27006:2011, HKCAS Supplementary Criteria No. 8, and all applicable HKAS and HKCAS supplementary criteria.

To apply for the accreditation, certification bodies should submit a duly completed application form HKCAS 005, application questionnaire HKCAS 019, the required supporting documents, and the appropriate application fee as listed in HKCAS 006 to HKAS Executive.

Certification bodies interested in seeking accreditation for ISMS certification may contact Dr. M K Kwok for further information.


