What is product certification (產品認證)?

◆ 'Product certification (產品認證)'-

A <u>third party certification body</u> (CB) issues a certificate to confirm that a product of a given supplier satisfies the requirements of a specified certification scheme

(由第三方認證機構發出證書以證明 經審核的產品符合特定的產品認證計 劃所規定的要求)







What is product certification (產品認證)?

- Product certification is carried out by product certification bodies which should conform to <u>ISO/IEC 17065</u>
- Certified products may bear a <u>certification mark</u> to demonstrate their quality, which can directly link to the conformity of the product with specified requirements








Why do we use product certification?

- Benefits for users
 - Confidence (e.g. products fulfill specified requirements)
 - Reliable quality of products
 - Better traceability of products
 - Further test not required
- Benefits for manufacturers
 - Third party certification body to assure the products complied with the specified requirements
 - Product requirements well defined in scheme
 - Reducing risk of non-compliance / rework / wastage
 - Through rigorous process control and/or surveillance

Accreditation of product certification







✓ Provide <u>enhanced</u> confidence



- Ensure certification body conforming to ISO/IEC 17065, e.g.
- Impartiality (公正性)
- Confidentiality (保密性)
- Competent demonstration
- Openness
- Access to information
- Responsiveness to complaints and appeals
- Responsibility





 ✓ Assess product certification body regularly by Accreditation Body (e.g. HKAS)



Monitor the performance of accredited certification bodies and indirectly the performance of product manufacturers

e.g. HKAS Executive will not accept certification schemes which <u>imply or claim</u> that certified products have functions or properties that <u>may be misleading or</u> potentially misleading.

HKAS Policy on Product and Management System Certification Schemes

- 1. INTRODUCTION
- 1.1 This document details HKAS policy on product and management system certification schemes that HKAS Executive grants accreditation under HKCAS. HKAS grants accreditation to certification bodies only for those certification schemes that satisfy the criteria set out in this document.
- 1.2 An applicant certification body shall ensure that a certification scheme it uses for seeking HKCAS accreditation satisfies the criteria set out in this document. To apply for accreditation, the applicant certification body shall provide details of the certification scheme and submit all relevant supporting documents to HKAS Executive. HKAS Executive will accept accreditation applications if the certification scheme satisfies the criteria set out in this document.
- 1.3 An accredited certification body shall ensure that a certification scheme it is accredited for continues to satisfy the criteria set out in this document. The accredited certification body shall inform HKAS Executive in writing immediately of any changes or proposed changes of the certification scheme that may affect its continuing conformity with the criteria set out in this document. Though it may be outside its reach, the accredited certification body shall make every effort to discuss with the parties concerned and come up with an action plan proposing measures to resolve the non-conformity or anticipated non-conformity. Normally, accredited certification body easy non-conformity arising from the changes within 6 months. Accreditation may be suspended or terminated when the certification scheme no longer satisfies the criteria set out in this document.
- 1.4 The criteria in this document do not immediately apply to existing schemes, i.e. schemes which had already been within the accreditation scopes of certification bodies under HKCAS at the time this document was issued. However, an existing scheme not



- Provides independent and impartial accreditation services.


